**CALL TO ORDER**

Member Heard called the Canvassing Board meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. in the office of the Supervisor of Elections, 119 W. Kaley Street, Orlando, FL.

**ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

Member Heard stated public notice of this meeting was provided in accordance with *Florida Statutes* in four (4) locations within Orange County by publishing a legal advertisement in the West Orange Times, posted on the Town's website, posted on the Supervisor of Elections' website, and on the Town's bulletin board.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Member Heard announced the floor was open for public comments to which none were made.

**REVIEW PROCEDURES FOR POST-ELECTION AUDIT**

Member Heard announced she was notified by the Supervisor of Elections office that they did not have any ballots that were questionable or required any review by the Canvassing Board.

Senior GIS Analyst John Velazquez stated that his department is responsible for verifying the precinct unofficial ballot results on Election Day. He presented the Board with a Summary Results Report for the unofficial results showing no unscanned ballots, along with the DS300 Voting Results Tape. He noted that verification teams were in place to confirm the results and requested the initials of the Board members. The Board members reviewed the items presented and initialed the Results Verification Control Form.

Vote-by-Mail Support Angela Ashby stated the Vote-By-Mail report had no changes or updates from Election Day.

Chief Technical Services Officer Luis Torres explained the Summary Results Report in more detail stating, according to *Florida Statutes*, most of the information on this report is confidential and exempt from public records; and further, stated the total ballot count is 542. He asked the Board to review the Summary Results Report and requested them to sign it as this report will be used for the Independent Audit (Clear Ballot).

**CERTIFY ELECTION AND DETERMINE RECOUNTS (if any)**

Member Heard announced no recounts were needed by the Supervisor of Elections office.

**RESULTS COMPILATION**

Chief Technical Services Officer Luis Torres presented the Board with the Official Results.

**MOTION:** Member Heard, seconded by Member Taylor, moved to Certify the Election Results and declare Joseph P. McMullen the winner of Seat 4, and all Charter Amendment Questions 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 passed. Motion carried unanimously.

Whereupon, the Canvassing Board signed the Official Results and Certified the March 10, 2026 Election (Attachment A).

**Charter Amendment Revising Procedures  
for Filling Town Commission Vacancies**

Amending the Town of Oakland Charter to revise, from 30 days to **90 days**, the time period in which the Town Commission must fill vacancies in its membership by appointment, and to provide that if not filled in that time, the vacancy shall be filled by special election, rather than appointment by the Governor.

**Question #2**  
**Charter Amendment Revising**  
**Town Commission Voting Thresholds**

The Town of Oakland Charter currently requires an affirmative vote of three (of five) Town Commission members to approve any matter if the other two Town Commission members are unavailable to vote due to abstention required by state law. Amending the Town Charter to apply this requirement to either the abstention, **or absence**, of two Town Commission Members.

**CONDUCT POST LOGIC AND ACCURACY TEST**

Vote-by-Mail Technician Cesar Castro verified with the Board that the tabulator was zeroed out. He then processed ballots through Machine D, DS950 (*VBM Tabulator for Oakland*), and printed the Summary Results Report. The Canvassing Board members compared the Summary Results Report for accuracy. The Board verified the pattern was correct; and further, the Canvassing Board members signed the dated the report. The ballots and report were placed in a box, the box was sealed and signed by the Board members, and Machine D, DS950, was zeroed out and shut down.

Vote-by-Mail Technician Cesar Castro verified with the Board that the tabulator was zeroed out. He then processed ballots through Machine E, DS950 (*VBM Tabulator for Oakland, Apopka & Maitland*) and printed the Summary Results Report. The Canvassing Board members compared the Summary Results Report and found it to be incorrect.

Vote-by-Mail Technician Cesar Castro printed a new Summary Results Report. The Canvassing Board members compared the Summary Results Report for accuracy. The Board verified the pattern was correct; and further, the Canvassing Board members signed

and dated the report. The ballots and report were placed in a box, the box was sealed and signed by the Board members, and Machine E, DS950, was zeroed out and shut down.

### **INDEPENDENT AUDIT**

(At their January 13, 2026 Meeting, the Canvassing Board approved the audit be conducted by Independent Audit.)

The Supervisor of Elections office processed the independent audit utilizing the Clear Ballot audit system on Thursday, March 12, 2026 at 3:00 p.m., where Member Heard was present, oversaw the process, and verified the results.

Chief Technical Services Officer Luis Torres briefed the Board on the independent audit process utilizing Clear Ballot, presented the Results Accuracy Report (*Attachment B*) and reported an overall accuracy of 99.995081%. He further presented the Comparison of Votes Cast Report (*Attachment C*), explained the comparisons listed with each vote and whether there were any differences. The Board members verified the audit results and signed the Comparison of Votes Cast Report, the Voting System Post-Election Audit Report (*Attachment D*) and the Contest Vote Discrepancy Threshold Report (*Attachment E*).

**MOTION:** Member Heard, seconded by Member Taylor, moved to approve the results of the Independent Audit. Motion carried unanimously.
